### Nightlight – Potential Fire Hazard

July 8, 2010, Caledonia, ON – Haldimand County Hydro has been made aware of one incident where a nightlight distributed by Haldimand County Hydro has been involved in a fire on July 7, 2010. Approximately 3,000 of the nightlights were distributed as part of a Conservation Awareness Program. The nightlights were distributed free of charge at events throughout the County in 2009 and 2010 including the Caledonia Santa Claus Parade.

The nightlights are shaped like a house, glow green and have “Haldimand County Hydro” along with the website address and “Every Kilowatt Counts” printed on the front. The back of the nightlight has the number E84892 and a UL Listed certification mark.

Haldimand County Hydro immediately notified the Electrical Safety Authority about the product and will work with the Electrical Safety Authority as they complete their investigation. The Electrical Safety Authority has opened an investigation into the product.

The Haldimand County Fire Department has been made aware of this matter.

Customers are urged to unplug the nightlights until further notice.
